



**CMDCM (SW/FMF/AW) MEDEA A. DUDLEY**

**Expeditionary Strike Group SEVEN /Task Force SEVEN SIX**

Command Master Chief Medea Dudley is a native of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago. She enlisted in the Navy in 1991 and attended boot camp in Orlando, FL followed by Hospital Corpsman “A” school in Great Lakes, IL, and Surgical Technologist “C” school at Naval School of Health Sciences in Norfolk VA.

Some of her sea duty commands are USS MCKEE (AS 41), USS GREENBAY (LPD 20), while onboard USS ESSEX (LHD 2) in Sasebo, Japan she completed numerous amphibious forward deployed exercises, including FOAL EAGLE 2000, TEADEM Thrust 01, Humanitarian Assistance Operations to East Timor and COBRA GOLD 2002. In 2008 she deployed onboard USNS MERCY (TAH 19) in support of Pacific

Partnership 08 (PP08.) to the Philippines, Vietnam and the Federated States of Micronesia.

Her shore duty assignments include Surgical Technology Instructor at Naval School of Health Sciences, San Diego and U.S. Naval Hospital in Naples, Italy, where she performed as the SEL for the Director for Administration and Acting Command Master Chief. In May 2011 she was selected to Senior Chief Petty Officer and in February 2012, selected into the Command Senior Chief Program.

She reported to NAVSUP Fleet Logistics Center San Diego in April 2014 and promoted to Command Master Chief in May 2014. Curtailing shore duty, CMCDM Dudley reported to USS PINCKNEY (DDG 91) in July 2015 and completed a 12 month Dry-dock Selected Restricted Availability (DSRA), and successfully completed Basic Phase, RIMPAC 16, GRUSAIL, SWATT, COMPTUEX, 2017 C5F and C7F AOR deployment earning DESRON NINE Unit Tactics award and the coveted Battle “E”.

CMDCM Dudley joined the crew of USS PRINCETON (CG 59) and completed a safe and successful SRA and Sea Trials, followed by a highly successful Basic Phase certification cycle; inspected at Class Average by Board of Inspection and Survey (INSURV), the ship earned the following awards: 2018 Retention Excellence, 2018 Carrier Strike Group 11 (CSG11) Unit Tactics, coveted 2018 Spokane Trophy.

Master Chief Dudley currently serves as Command Master Chief, Expeditionary Strike Group SEVEN/Task Force SEVEN SIX Sasebo, Japan in July 2022 after serving as Command Master Chief of 1<sup>st</sup> Marine Aircraft Wing in Okinawa, Japan where she responsible for all Marine Corps aviation assets and personnel in MCB Kaneohe Bay, MCAS Futema and MCAS Iwakuni.

Her personal achievements and awards include: Naval War College Senior Enlisted Academy #179, graduate of Keystone 18-1, MCPON’s Executive Leadership Symposium, CMC/COB class 126, Legion of Merit (1), Meritorious Service Medal (4), Navy and Marine Corps Commendation Medal (5), Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medal (4) and various Campaign and unit awards.
